Scholarship Eligibility:

Students must be graduating 8th grade from Daniel Wright Junior High School

Scholarship Amount:

Full scholarship is \$2500. \$500 will be awarded upon graduating from 8th grade and \$2,000 awarded upon graduating from high school and enrollment in a post-high school educational institution. Note: students can graduate from high school of any school district.

Scholarship Application Guidelines

Applications are accepted on-line only.

Each applicant will complete the application form, and two letters of recommendation (one from a teacher, one from a community member). Incomplete or falsified applications will be disqualified.

Scholarship applicants may be asked to provide additional information.

Scholarship Notification

Scholarship recipient shall be notified after the Learning Fund Foundation (LFF) has given final approval of the scholarship award recipients.

LFF shall provide the scholarship recipient with a letter notifying the student applicant of the grant. The letter shall inform the student applicant that \$500 will be disbursed upon graduating 8th grade, and \$2,000 will be disbursed when LFF receives confirmation that the student is enrolled in a post-high school educational institution. The student will have to notify LFF what their post high school plans are by May 31st of the calendar year following the high school graduation. If LFF does not receive this notification by Dec 31st of the calendar year following the high school graduation, this money will be applied to future scholarships.

The recipient shall be required to sign and return a copy of the letter indicating acceptance of the scholarship.

Scholarship Record Keeping:

LFF shall keep records which shall include:

- 1. All information that the Foundation used to evaluate the qualification of potential scholarship recipient
- 2. The name, address, and other contact or identifying information for each scholarship recipient
- 3. A copy of the letter notifying the recipient of the scholarship grant
- 4. Follow up information obtained under section "Scholarship Investigation and Enforcement Procedures"

Scholarship Investigation and Enforcement Procedures

LFF reserves the right to withdraw an offer of scholarship under various conditions, including if a student engages in behavior that brings in question their honesty or moral character.
